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
# 12 DAYS Adventure Namibia

<b>Day 1</b>	<b>Depart for Windhoek, Namibia</b>	
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Depart for **Windhoek**, capital of Namibia in South Western part of Africa.

<b>Day 2</b>	<b>Arrive Windhoek / Otjiwarongo</b>	<b>D</b>
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Arrive in **Windhoek**. Transfer to **Otjiwarongo area (290km)** for overnight stay.

**Overnight Okonjima Lodge or similar**

<b>Day 3</b>	<b>Otjiwarongo / Etosha National Park</b>	<b>B, L, D</b>
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In the morning visit the work of the **Africat Foundation at Okonjima**; where cheetahs which cannot be released back into the wild as they were either brought up as pets and hand-raised, or have injuries.

Travel to **Etosha Game Park (170km)**. Excellent wildlife viewing from the Waterhole.

**Overnight Okakuejo Camp, Etosha Game Park or similar**

<b>Day 4</b>	<b>Etosha National Park / Himba Village / Twyfelfontein</b>	<b>B, L, D</b>
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Morning visit to a typical **Himba village**.

*Damaraland and the Kaokoveld are home to the Himba, one of the last truly traditional tribes on the planet. These friendly people lead a semi-nomadic life as herdsman, breeding mainly cattle and goats.*

We depart for **Twyfelfontein (320km)** to visit the **Organ Pipes, Petrified Forest** and the **Rock Engravings**. *The beautiful organ pipes are a fascinating geological formation located near Twyfelfontein. Strikingly rich rusty colors are portrayed in long columns resembling those of a church organ dating back 120 million years. The Rock Art site is recognised as UNESCO World Heritage site as the most important rock engraving sites in southern Africa, be inspired by the remarkable 2,000 years in history of wild animals and footprints.*

**Overnight Twyfelfontein Country Lodge or similar**

<b>Day 5</b>	<b>Twyfelfontein / Swakopmund</b>	<b>B, L, D</b>
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After breakfast we drive to **Cape Cross Seal Reserve (260km)**.

The coastline of Southern Africa is the only place in the world where you find Cape fur seals and the Cape Cross Seal Reserve is home to the largest breeding colony in the world. Based on aerial photographs taken during the breeding season, there are up to 210 000 seals at Cape Cross during November and December.

Continue onto pretty **Swakopmund (75km)**, a place founded by Germans in the 19<sup>th</sup> century.

**Overnight Swakopmund Plaza Hotel or similar**

<b>Day 6</b>	<b>Walvis Bay Marine &amp; Bay Excursion</b>	<b>B, L, D</b>
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After breakfast we travel to **Walvis Bay** for the **Marine & Dune excursion**.

The tour starts with the **Marine Cruise** where you will see Pelican Point, Oyster Farms, Bird Island, Lighthouse, Walvis Bay Lagoon, Saltpans, Kuiseb River Delta and Mudflats of Sandwich Harbour.

After the cruise, enjoy a **4WD excursion into the Dunes**. Your guide & land rover are waiting to meet you, taking you out to the dunes and protected Sandwich harbor area. Enjoy a light lunch on a sandbank.

**Overnight Swakopmund Plaza Hotel or similar**

<b>Day 7</b>	<b>Swakopmund / Sossusvlei</b>	<b>B, L, D</b>
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Today after breakfast we travel to **Sossusvlei (300km) with a drive through Welwitschia Drive and Moonlandscape** en route. Afternoon sunset drive into the desert.

*The Welwitschia is endemic to Namib Desert. Although the plant looks as if it has many leaves, it has only two. The oldest living specimens are estimated at 1500 to 2000 years.*

*The Sossusvlei, Namibia's famous highlight in the heart of the Namib Desert (the world's oldest desert), is a huge clay pan, enclosed by giant sand dunes. Some of the spectacular hills of sand are, at a height of 300 metres, the highest in the world.*

**Overnight Desert Hills Lodge or similar**

<b>Day 8</b>	<b>Sossusvlei</b>	<b>B, L, D</b>
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Early morning, enter **Sossusvlei** area and enjoy the sunrise when the dunes come alive in morning light. Give a try to climb to the top of **Dune 45** before sunrise for a stunning desert scenery, or challenge yourself for a strenuous hike at the 325 m high **Big Daddy Dune**. Proceed to **Dead Vlei**, a white clay pan dotted with ancient trees where was once an oasis. End the tour by exploring **Sesriem Canyon**, a deep chasm carved through the rocks by water over millions of years.

*Overnight Desert Hills Lodge or similar*

<b>Day 9</b>	<b>Sossusvlei / Kalahari</b>	<b>B, L, D</b>
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An early start for the drive into the **Kalahari (330km)**, home of the legendary Bushmen. Enjoy the beautiful surroundings of your lodging and soak in the atmosphere of the Kalahari.

*Overnight Suricate Kalahari Tented Lodge or similar*

<b>Day 10</b>	<b>Kalahari / Windhoek</b>	<b>B, L, D</b>
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You will participate in an exciting **"Bushman Walk"** in the Kalahari where they will teach you their survival secrets.

The term **'Bushman'** known as the San people, refers to the nomadic hunter-gatherers indigenous to this area. The San People know the Kalahari Desert better than any other human beings and have survived the dry conditions for generations. They are hunter-gatherers, hunting with bows and arrows, trapping small animals and eating edible roots and berries and they eagerly demonstrate this to guests.

We then depart for **Windhoek (250km)**.

*Overnight AVANI Windhoek Hotel & Casino or similar*

<b>Day 11</b>	<b>Depart Windhoek</b>	<b>B</b>
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Morning **Windhoek City tour**.

*Windhoek sits in the heart of Namibia, in the midst of the country's Central Highlands. Aside from its European population, the city is a rich mix of Namibian ethnicities: Owambo, Kavango, Damara, Caprivian, Nama and San people all make their home here.*

Transfer to airport for flight home.
