DAY 1 CHECK IN AIRPORT

DAY 2 ARRIVE RIO de JANEIRO, BRAZIL (3N) (D)

Depart for your South American adventure.

Arrive in one of the most exciting and beautiful city in the world, **Rio De Janeiro**, Brazil, home of the world famous Carnival & Samba! Transfer to your hotel located just a few steps from the world famous Copacabana Beach.

On arrival, transfer to hotel for rest and dinner.

DAY 3 RIO DE JANEIRO (B, L, D)

Sugar Loaf Mountain – The panoramic view from the top of the Sugar Loaf Mountain, at 1,296ft above sea-level is breath taking. Two sets of cable cars elevate you to the top of Sugar Loaf. From its summit, passengers will get a magnificent 360degrees view of Rio & its golden beaches, green forests & thriving metropolis.

Historic Rio Tour – sightseeing continues with a tour of Rio's historical past. Learn how Portugal's prince Dom Pedro I scandalously broke all family ties and declared himself Emperor of Brazil, as you see the sites of Rio de Janeiro. On the way to downtown, drive through Parque do Flamengo. Pass by the National Library, the Opera House, and get a sense of Rio's glamour.

DAY 4 RIO DE JANEIRO (B, L, D)

Christ the Redeemer – This famous statue keeps an eye out on Rio with its outstretched arms. Board the **tremzinho (cogwheel railway)** up to the top of **Corcovado Mountain** for a bird eye's view of the centre of Rio.

After **BBQ dinner**, enjoy **Rio by Night Ginga Tropical Show**.

A Brazilian dance show that gathers on stage various cultures of our Tropical Country. The show combines a variety of Brazilian dances that developed from African rhythms via the slave trade and the natives that lived in Brazil before colonization. A breathtaking, must see show is located in one of the most beautiful hotels of Rio de Janeiro.

DAY 5 RIO DE JANEIRO / IGUASSU FALLS, BRAZIL (2Nights) (B, L, D)

Transfer to airport for your flight to Iguassu Falls.

Enjoy a guided visit of Brazil's **Iguacu National Park**. After checking out the exhibits in the visitors' center, take a bus ride to visit various vantage points that will reward you with a panoramic view of the falls. An elevator up to a lookout platform provides a bird's eye view of this UNESCO World Heritage Site. The most stunning waterfall is the Devils Throat, which spans a 2,700 semi- circle that gushes over a height of 72 m (236 ft).

DAY 6 IGUASSU FALLS / LIMA, PERU (B, L)

A morning tour will take you across the Tancredo Neves Bridge over the Iguassu River, which forms the border between Argentina & Brazil, to the Argentine side of the falls and National Park. Once in Argentina, follow a scenic highway up the Argentine Iguazu Park. Visit starts with ample time to visit San Martin's Falls & the Devil's Throat. We will enjoy the traditional circuits in the Iguazu National Park: the Upper Circuit and the Lower Circuit. The Upper Circuit guarantees spectacular panoramic views of the falls. The Lower Circuit will give us a close contact with the falls and surrounding vegetation.

Afternoon, embark on a **Great Adventure Boat Ride Under Falls** and prepare to get wet! Your guide will lead you along the Sendero Yacaratia Trail to a panoramic viewpoint, and reach the Puerto Macuco to board the motorboat. Climb aboard for the ride through the Iguassu River Canyon, and prepare to get soaked as the boat approaches the bottom of the falls. Feel the spray and see the rainbows as water rushes around you. Then continue to the San Martin waterfalls, the tallest in Iguazu. At the end of the boat ride, you'll disembark at the lower circuit trail.

Transfer to airport for flight to Lima. On arrival, transfer to hotel for overnight.

DAY 7 LIMA

(B, L, D)

Lima city tour begins at the Plaza de Armas, where the **Cathedral, Archbishop's Palace, and Government Palace** are located. Then you'll have the chance to visit one of Lima's colonial jewels: The Monastery of San Francisco or the Convent of Santo Domingo, to admire the quaint colonial architecture of these buildings and learn about the influence of Catholicism in the country.

Enjoy a **typical Peruvian Lunch with Pisco Sour Tasting**.

Then, visit the **Larco Museum**, which holds the finest precious metals collection in Peru. Housed in a royal mansion of the 18th-century, the museum is famous for its gold and silver collection, its erotic archaeological collection, and its pre-Columbian art collection. There are over 45,000 objects, all classified by culture and theme in chronological order.

We will finish our tour in the modern district of Miraflores, where we will be able to enjoy a magnificent view of the Pacific Ocean.

DAY 8 LIMA / CUZCO (2N)

(B, L, D)

Morning flight to **Cuzco**, the old capital of the Inca Empire from the 13th to 15th century. It is a rich mixture of Inca and Colonial Spanish architecture and a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site.

Cuzco City Walking Tour

Visit **Korikancha**, known as the Temple of the Sun during the Inca Empire, and now is the site of the Santo Domingo Convent. You'll also see the **Cathedral**, which faces the **Plaza de Armas** in the heart of downtown Cusco.

Ruins Tour

Sacsayhuaman is one of the most important Inca sites in Cusco and was most likely a ceremonial center or fortress during the time of the Incan Empire. Embedded in the hillside are gigantic stones that make up the foundation of the site. Fitted together with precision, Sacsayhuaman's stones are an impressive glimpse at Incan stonemasonry skill. Continue to **Q'enko**, located further on the hillside overlooking Cuzco. Here you can see several intricate stone carvings of important Inca symbols, including the puma. There are also aqueducts and ceremonial altars. From a distance you will see the ruins of **Puca Pucara** and then visit the **Tambo Machay royal baths**.

DAY 9 MACHU PICCHU

(B, L)

An exciting day, as you wake up early to take the **Vistadome train to Aguas Calientes for Machu Picchu**, South America's most spectacular archaeological site. The train journey with its spectacular scenery where you will be able to glimpse a condor in flight is a highlight of any trip to the Andes. Machu Picchu, the Lost City of the Incas, is one of the wonders of the Americas. The stunning ruins of the ancient citadel, perched on a mountain peak high in the Andes, is the greatest surviving testament to Inca civilization. Built in the 15th century, it was the secret city of the Incas, never discovered by the Spanish until discovered in 1911 by an American explorer. Return to Cuzco in the evening.

Transfer to airport for flight to Buenos Aires. On arrival, transfer to hotel.

(B, L, D)

Today proceed for **city tour** which takes in the sights such as the symbol of Buenos Aires; the Obelisk, Plaza de Mayo, elegant Plaza San Martin and Colon Theatre. Proceed on to the traditional neighbourhoods of La Boca, and San Telmo. Stroll through the elegant neighbourhood of Recoleta & trendy Palermo. Finally visit Puerto Madero, Buenos Aires' old port.

Flight to El Calafate.

DAY 12 RIOS de HIELO EXPRESS EXCURSION (B, L, D)

This navigation covers the northern arm of **Lake Argentino**. The tour goes through the **Spegazzini and the Upsala glaciers**, entering the bays that they form and also includes sailing in the cord of icebergs located about 20 km from the Upsala glacier.

The first part of the excursion is in the northern arm of Lake Argentino across the Boca del Diablo, the narrowest part of the lake, then you will go to the Upsala channel and the Spegazzini channel where you are able to see, at the end of each channel, the respective glaciers. The navigation runs between spectacular icebergs of immense size and varied forms. From the boat you will see, among others, the Upsala, the Spegazzini and the Perito Moreno glaciers, the largest and highest respectively among all glaciers in the park. Box Lunch.

DAY 13 PERITO MORENO GLACIER EXCURSION / BUENOS AIRES (1N) (B, L)

Enjoy the most popular and important excursion in the area. The **Perito Moreno Glacier** is a spectacle difficult to describe, that fills the visitor with amazement and admiration, even from the first sights several kilometers away on the road. The trip from El Calafate to the glacier is a succession of lakes, streams, woods and snowcapped mountains. Six km before reaching your destination you get to a vantage point with the first panoramic view of the Glacier, widely known as "Curva de los Suspiros" (Sighs Bend). Finally, the road ends in the western tip of Magallanes Peninsula where, with your feet on the ground and the amazing 5 km-high front of the glacier at your side you get to the footbridges to take a closer look at the glacier. Afternoon transfer to airport for flight to Buenos Aires. Box lunch.

DAY 14 COLONIA del SACRAMENTO, URUGUAY DAY TRIP (B, L, D)

Take a ferry from Buenos Aires to the oldest town in **Uruguay – Colonia del Sacramento**. This Old Portuguese city from the 17th century has been declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site for its well conserved architectural structure. With its cobble stoned streets, charming old colonial buildings and historic landmarks, Colonia is a beautiful old fashioned town filled with extraordinary charm. Colonia serves as an excellent day trip to visit because of its nice shops, museums and restaurants. Return to Buenos Aires in the late afternoon.

Tonight's highlight is the passionate **Latin Tango show & Dinner**. Inside, you will be served dinner as amazing dancers perform in a unique tango show. Witnessing a tango show is one of the distinctive experiences you can have in Buenos Aires, which is the city where the tango dance was born.

Tigre & North Delta

A short 1.30-hour ride from Buenos Aires towards the north area, entering Buenos Aires province, takes you to a place with zig-zagging rivers, a lush vegetation, and more than 200 bird species: Tigre. Sail through the Parana River delta on a catamaran boat and take in the natural beauty of the area. Learn about the customs and lifestyle of the islanders, with curiosities such as the 'lancha almacén' (grocery boat), which sells goods at a certain time of the day.
